Install the side rails on the mount with provided screws. (Optional) Install proper rings and long eye relief scope (Recommended: AccuShot 1" Scope 4-16x44, 30mm Scope 3-9x44, 6-24x56) on the top rail, and install Tactical Flashlight and Laser Sight on the side rails.





After assuring that your firearm is in good working order, you are ready to zero your scope at a suitable firing range.



ADDITIONAL SIDE RAILS



CORRECT INSTALLATION

Slide the UTG mount toward the Front Barrel Clip, and align the Sliding Grooves of the mount to accept the Front Barrel Clip, and then push the front end of the mount into the Front Band housing.

Place the Back Barrel Clip (with larger arc) onto the barrel behind the Operating Rod Guide.

Pull the Operating Rod backward and hold the Rod to allow enough room for the Back Barrel Clip to move freely. Twist the mount outward and set enough distance away from the barrel to insert the right side of the Back Barrel Clip into the Sliding Groove of the mount.

Follow the manufacturer's manual to remove the buttstock and upper handguard from the firearm. Turn the firearm upside down with gas tube above the barrel. Place the receiver in a vise with padded jaws to protect the firearm. Position the Front Barrel Steel Clip (with smaller arc) next to the Front Band between the gas tube and the barrel. And, hold the Clip next to the Front Band.

Close the distance between the mount and the barrel, and twist the mount inward against the barrel for the tightest fit to allow the left side of the Back Barrel Clip to be inserted into the other Sliding Groove.

Align the screw holes of the Front and the Back Barrel Clips with the corresponding screw holes on the mount, and turn the firearm upside up - barrel above the gas tube.

Twist to adjust the mount around the barrel to make sure that the mount is parallel to the bore centerline.

Examine the alignments of the screw holes of the Front and the Back Barrel Clips with the corresponding screw holes on the mount. Uniformly tighten installation screws for a firm lock of Barrel Clips, Barrel and the Mount. Tighten the thumbscrew into the thread on the receiver using the provided gasket for snug fit. Follow the manufacturer's manual to reinstall the buttstock.
