





HANDGUARD INSTALLATION: UPPER HALF



Remove the handquard and handquard retainer pin. Lock charging handle to the rear in its locking recess notch.



Place the upper half of the handguard over the top of the receiver making sure the charging handle passes through and the receiver's claw mount interface is aligned with the handguard's corresponding mounting holes. There are four mounting holes, two on the left and two on the right side of the handquard.



Four locking lugs are included and are individually engraved with an arrow symbol. Insert each locking lug through the mounting holes with their arrows pointed upwards.

Orientate the lower half of the handguard so that its integral QD sockets are towards the muzzle.
